Dear Motorcycle Owners,

CRIME ALERT: MOTORS VEHICLE THEFTS

Recently, there a few cases of motorcycle thefts had occurred at Telok Blangah Crescent Multi Storey car parks (MSCP) and void decks.

2 Generally, culprits use similar-sized keys to insert into the ignition keyhole and start the engine through forced ignition. They commonly strike either late at night or in the wee hours of the morning when human and vehicular traffic are low.

Crime Prevention Measures

3 We urge you to take extra precaution in protecting your motorcycle and consider adopting the following prevention measures:

- a Fit additional locking devices such as front wheel safety lock, cable lock or disc locks for your motorcycle;
- b Install an anti-theft alarm or motion sensor alarm. The alarm should be regularly checked and serviced to ensure its effectiveness;
- c Remove the ignition key whenever your motorcycle is left unattended, even for a short while;
- d Park in well-lit areas; and
- e Always check that you have secured your motorcycle before leaving.
