Dear Residents of Theresa Ville,

CRIME PREVENTION ADVISORY- KILLER LITTER

In January 2010, several cases of killer litter were reported at Theresa Ville. Broken pieces of plastic flower pots and an ashtray were found near the swimming pool, believed to be thrown from the units above. Fortunately, no one was hurt.

2. High-rise littering is a socially irresponsible act which could damage properties and cause serious injuries, even death. If convicted by a criminal court, offenders may be fined, jailed or both.

3. Police would like to remind residents of Theresa Ville to dispose of rubbish or unwanted things in a proper and responsible manner. Residents should also adopt the following measures:

- a. Conduct regular checks on casement windows and aircon ledges; and
- b. Never place objects such as potted plants, pails or ashtrays on window or corridor ledges, even for a short period of time as they are potential hazards.

4 We seek your cooperation to keep the estate safe and hazard free.
