CRIME ADVISORY: THEFT OF VALUABLES

Recently, there has been an increase of theft cases at the National University Hospital (NUH). These cases were mostly committed in the wards, specialist clinics, food court and staff locker rooms. Many of these cases were the results of staffs, patients, visitors to the hospital leaving their belongings unattended, thus creating opportunities for thefts to occur.

2 Such thefts could be prevented if the owners had taken adequate preventive measures such as the followings:

- Do not leave your valuables such as your hand phones, wallets, cash and jewellery unattended.
- Do not use your handbag, briefcase, wallet and hand phones to reserve seats in public areas such as the food courts, café and waiting area.
- Always keep your personal belongings in your view or in provided lockers or drawers with locking facilities.
