CRIME PREVENTION ADVISORY – BICYCLE THEFT

Recently, a few cases of bicycles were reported stolen from your neighbourhood. In these cases, the bicycles were placed outside the house and secured with a bicycle chain. However, the culprit(s) is believed to have cut the bicycle chain to steal the bicycles.

2 We would like to take this opportunity to advise residents to be vigilant and adopt the following crime prevention measures:

- a. Secure your bicycle at a designated bicycle stand and use good quality lock and chain like the U-locks (which resemble a large pad-lock) to provide better security as compared to chain locks and cable locks;

- b. Bicycles are best kept inside your home, when not in use; and
- c. Make permanent identification marks (e.g. name, NRIC number, etc.) on the bicycle frame/wheels. This will make it difficult for the thief to dispose of the bicycle and also facilitate recovery if it is stolen.
