Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Entertainments and Meetings (Art Exhibitions) (Exemption) Order.

Exemption

2. Any art exhibition organised or sponsored by any organisation, association or society specified in the First Schedule, and held in any place or premises or part thereof set out in the Second Schedule, is exempted from the Act if the following conditions are complied with:

- (a) the exhibition is of still objects such as paintings, sculptures, flower arrangements, or of other forms of representation by still objects; and
- (b) the public or any class of the public has gratuitous access to the place or premises or part thereof where the exhibition is held.
